TEACHER ONLY DAY

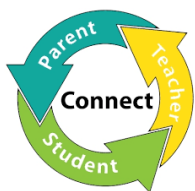

Koraunui Piwakawaka (Y3/4 Coach Rosie) – 12:30am court 6

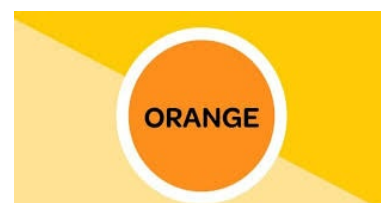


We are on duty at the courts this weekend, we do this just once in the season.

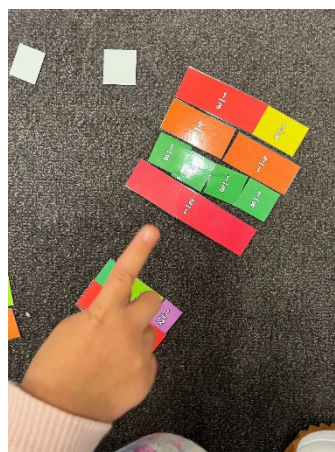
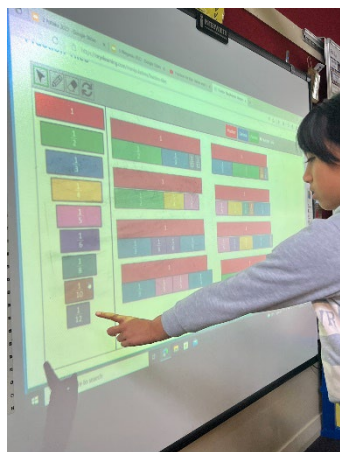


WHAT'S HAPPENING AROUND THE SCHOOL
